Daisy's Mum – looks after and cares for Daisy in the story

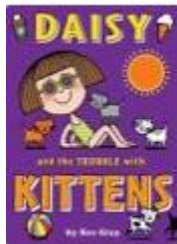
Daisy's Grandparents 'Nanny & Grampy' – very generously paid for the holiday that Daisy and her Mum could go on.

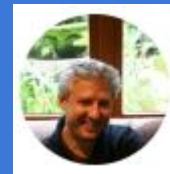
