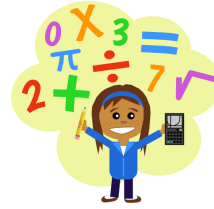

## Attendance Ted

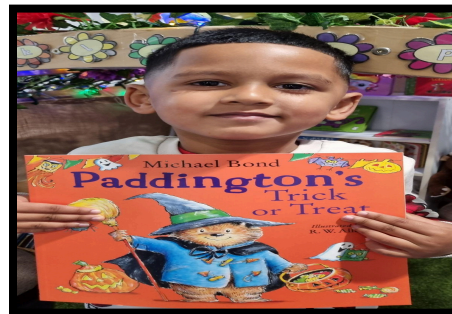


Well done Magpie class who have achieved best overall attendance.

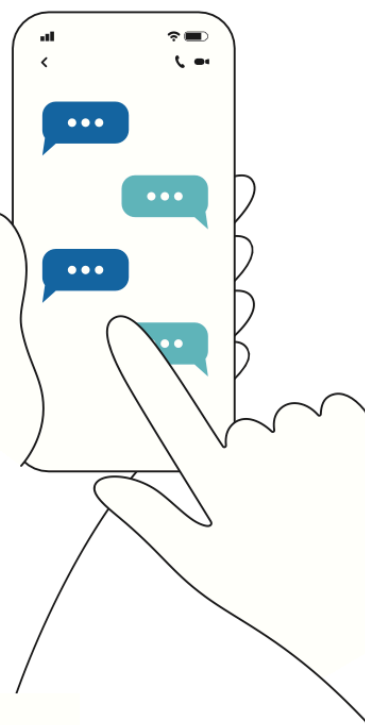

## Westbrook Recommended Reads

### Early Years (Reception)

**Book:** Zog by Julia Donaldson & Axel Scheffler



This is the story about a dragon called Zog, who is determined to try his best at dragon school but doesn't always manage to win the teacher's gold star. The story shows how perseverance and following dreams can lead to positive outcomes, and that different people's strengths emerge in different situations.

### Key Stage 1 (Year 1 & 2)

**Book:** The Dinosaur Next Door by David Litchfield



A young girl called Liz knows her neighbour's secret identity, but none of the grown-ups will listen. After a little gentle sleuthing, Liz uncovers a spectacular, magical world of dinosaurs where her enormous friend truly belongs.

### Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3 & 4)

**Book:** A Mermaid's Diary by Chris Riddell



The mermaid, Atalanta Scrimshaw, is a breath of fresh air. Her world is exciting with its friendly creatures, and her best friend, Creech, is brilliantly entertaining! I loved Creech's explanations of the human world! When faced with the destruction of their favourite beaches, the friends must work together to save their world.

### Upper Key Stage 2 (Year 5 & 6)

**Book:** The Time Travellers by Sufiya Ahmed & Alessia Trunfio



On a school trip to the Houses of Parliament, they find themselves magically transported back in time to 1911. They find themselves in the middle of a women's suffrage demonstration, where, as well as meeting more familiar characters like Emily Davison, Suhana is thrilled to encounter Lolita Roy and other women of Indian heritage protesting for the right to vote too.
