

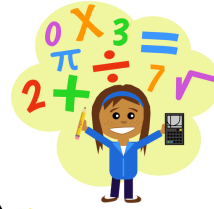

The nursery has been reading *The Little Red Hen*. They have been learning about the life cycle of a hen and counting the eggs laid in the hen house each day and recording the number on a chart. They have also been using their measuring skills to weigh the flour and using their science skills to talk about how the dough mixture changed when it went in the oven. The children were able to enjoy their baking by eating warm buttery bread rolls when they were cooked.
