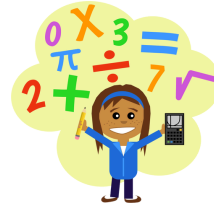

Remember to send your child into school with a T-shirt that represents their House colour.

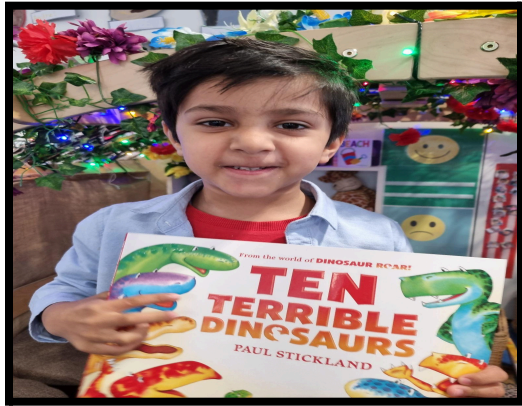
They will tell you if it's either Red, Yellow ,Blue or Green.
