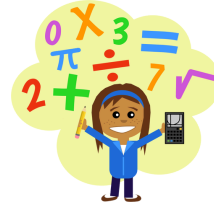

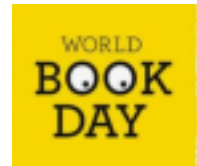

Well done Harrier class who have achieved best overall attendance.



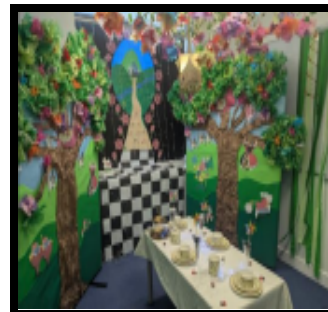
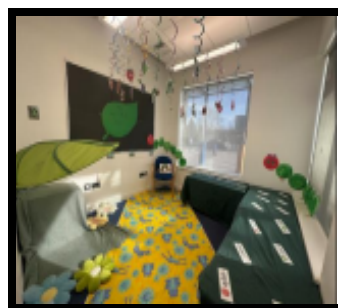
## World Book Day 2025 at Westbrook!
