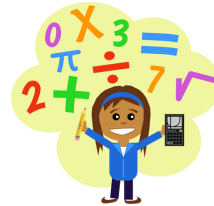

Attendance And Term Time Leave

As we are fast approaching our half term holidays we would like to remind all of our families about the school's attendance policy regarding term-time leave. Please be aware that **no term-time leave (TTL)** will be authorised for the following reasons:

- Weddings
- Family functions
- Travelling abroad for religious occasions
- Visiting family after a long period of time
- Concern about family members getting older and not knowing how long they may have left
- Taking advantage of cheaper tickets outside of holiday periods
- Unable to book tickets for the exact date during half term due to high demand
- Medical treatment abroad
- Unsure of holiday dates and accidentally booked the wrong dates (Term Time dates are locate on our school website)

The **only exception** for authorised term-time leave will be in cases of **critical illness** or **death** of a close family member.

If you believe your situation meets the criteria for exceptional term-time leave, please submit a request using the online form available on the school website. Following your submission, you will be required to meet with Dr. Tatters, Headteacher, prior to making any travel arrangements.

We ask all parents and carers to carefully consider the impact of term-time leave on their child's education, as well as the potential financial consequences. Please note, any unauthorised term-time leave, for statutory school age pupils, will result in a referral to the Local Authority and may result in a **fixed penalty notice** and/or **court proceedings**. Additionally, please be aware that schools do not hold places indefinitely, and there is a risk of losing your child's school place if you take extended unauthorised leave.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in ensuring that your child's education remains a priority.
