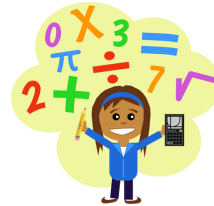

Starting in a school nursery class in September 2025

Children born between **1 September 2021** and **31 August 2022** can take up a free, part-time place in a school nursery class from the September before their fourth birthday.

Apply directly to the Hounslow schools you want. You must send a separate application form to each school you want to apply for.

The closing date for applications is **7 March 2025**.
