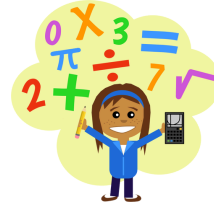

We would like to say a big **'Happy Birthday'** to Kira (Sparrow Class), Mia (Snowy Owl) and Tanmayi (Peacock Class).

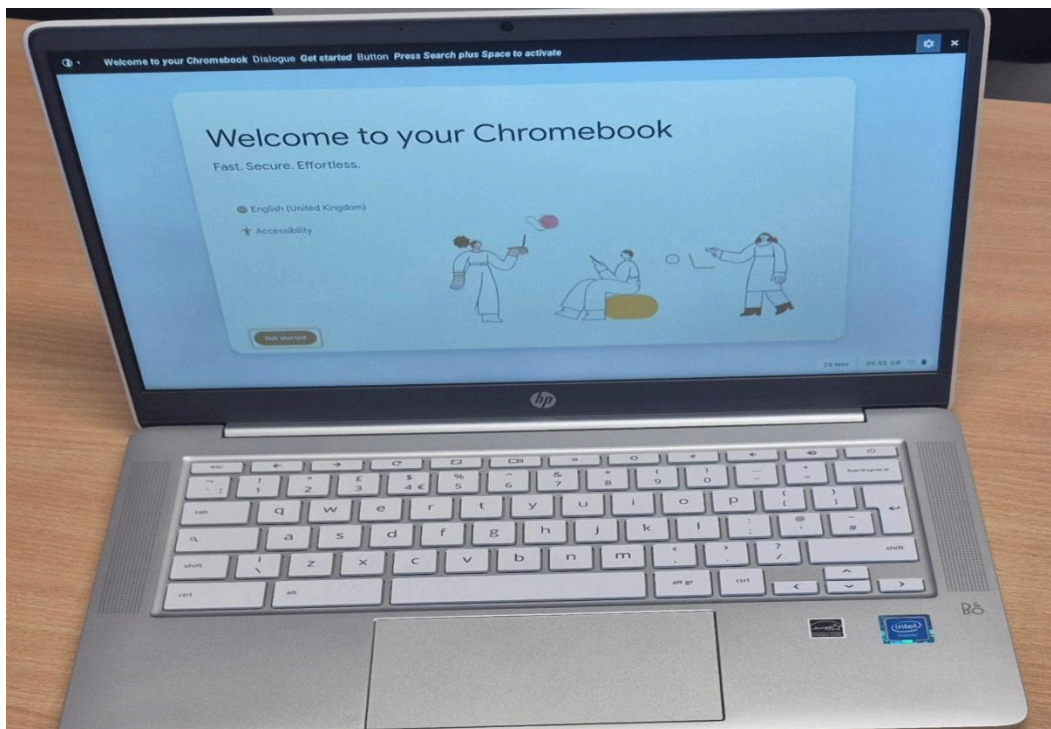
