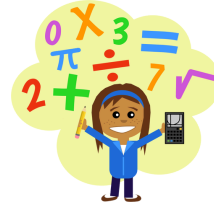

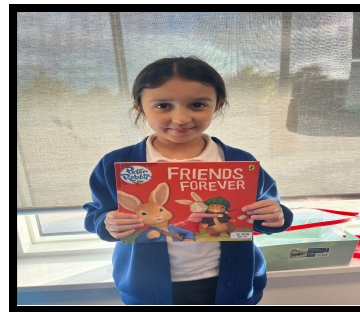
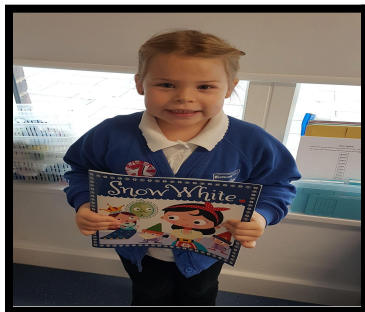
Attendance Ted

British Museum

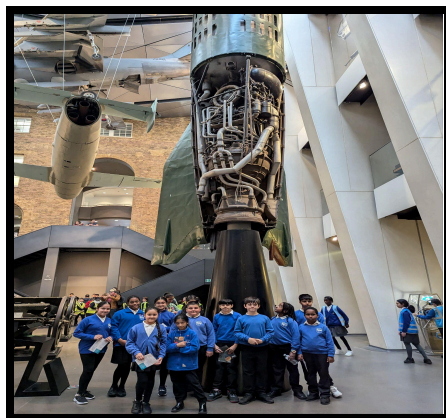
Year 4 children visited the British Museum last week and they learnt more about our history topic: Ancient Egyptians. This experience allowed them to explore amazing Egyptian artifacts that show what life was like in the ancient Nile Valley.

The trip was a fantastic chance for the children to connect with ancient Egypt's rich history, bringing our lessons to life in a memorable way!



Imperial War Museum

Year 6 enjoyed an inspiring and eye-opening visit to the Imperial War Museum, where history came vividly to life. Immersed in displays on World War I and II, children gained insight into how these events shaped the lives of ordinary people and the courage shown by those who served. Highlights included viewing authentic artifacts—soldiers' uniforms, a Spitfire hanging above, and powerful displays of wartime vehicles. Listening to stories of resilience and sacrifice, children felt a powerful connection to their studies, sparking meaningful discussions and leaving them with a deeper appreciation for history.
