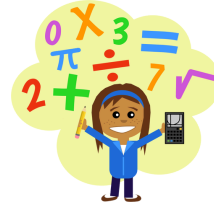

Healthy Start scheme

Do you have a child under four? Are you expecting a baby? As part of the School Superzone project, to encourage children to eat healthy food from an early age, we are raising awareness about the Healthy Start scheme. This is a national scheme for low-income families for help to buy healthy foods via a pre-loaded store card. Eligibility is income-based and runs from the 10th week of pregnancy until the child's 4th birthday. Pregnant women under 18 are eligible regardless of income.
