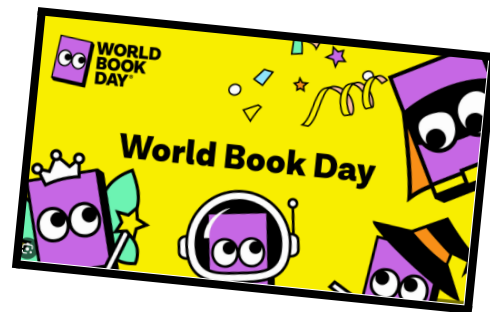

## Learning at Westbrook - Year 1

The children enjoyed **learning outdoors** as the weather was beautiful. During the **art lesson**, they explored **primary colours** and experimented with mixing them to create **secondary colours**. During a maths activity, the children practised measuring different objects using non-standard

units. They compared sizes and lengths using items such as blocks and other materials, helping them develop their early measuring and problem-solving skills.



## Year 6 visit to the Houses of Parliament

Last week, **Harrier Class** enjoyed an exciting visit to the **Houses of Parliament** as part of their learning in history and PSHE. The trip helped bring their understanding of **British values and democracy** to life, including how laws are made, how voting works and how elections are held.



The children took part in a guided tour of the historic building and the children were lucky enough to sit inside the **House of Commons**, where important debates take place.

It was a memorable visit and the pupils represented the school brilliantly, with their excellent behaviour and enthusiasm.

## Overview

Learn how diet affects mood, behaviour and learning in neurodivergent children, with practical tips to support your child and family.

Are you a parent or carer of a child or young person with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and wondering how nutrition might support their learning, behaviour, mood or wellbeing? This practical, evidence-informed talk explores how nutrition can support the neurodivergent brain – in a way that feels realistic, compassionate and achievable for families navigating SEND.
