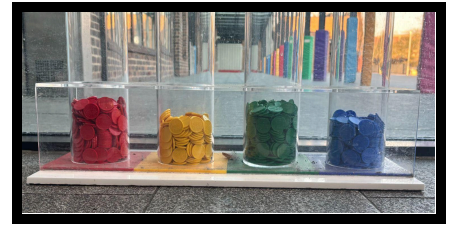
## Attendance Ted

## Birthday Books



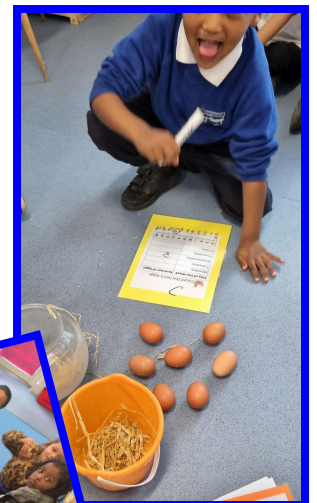

## Learning at Westbrook - Nursery

The Nursery children have been reading **The Little Red Hen** this week; they have learnt about how wheat is grown and ground to make flour. The **children weighed the ingredients**, made their own bread rolls and talked about how the dough changed when cooked in the oven. The children enjoyed eating their bread rolls very much. The children have also been using their mathematical skills to count and record how many eggs the hens have laid this week.



## Westbrook Exit Point - Year 4

Year 4 welcomed families to their exit point linked to their art topic, fabrics and craft, within the wider theme of **Fabric of Nature**. The children proudly shared their learning through a

range of **colourful masks, Maya-inspired artwork, paintings and creative craft pieces** influenced by nature and the Maya civilisation. Families were invited into the hall to view the children's work, speak to them about their learning and take part in **creative activities together**. The afternoon also

included dance performances linked to the topic, making it a **wonderful celebration of the children's creativity, confidence and enthusiasm**.



## Life skills at Westbrook...

Year 1 and 2 took part in a virtual '**Dental Workshop**' with nine other Hounslow schools to celebrate **National Smile Month**. The Hounslow Dental team reminded the children of the importance of healthy eating, correct procedures for brushing your teeth and presented lots of interesting facts about teeth.



*Did you know children have 20 baby teeth and when you become an adult it increases to 32? A story was read too and the workshop ended with a boogie to K-Pop Demon Hunters! The children all learnt two key messages: **to brush your teeth twice a day for 2 minutes and to regularly visit the dentist.***



# Westbrook off-site visit - Year 6

Year 6 had an amazing time visiting **Kew Gardens** to learn about **evolution** and the discoveries of **Charles Darwin**. The children explored different plants from around the world and discovered how living things **adapt to survive** in their environments. They learned that Darwin studied nature carefully and developed the **theory of evolution**, explaining that species change over time through **natural selection**. The class enjoyed observing unusual plants and discussing how animals and plants have **evolved** over millions of years to **suit their habitats**. The children felt wonderful reaching the centre of the treetop walk way.
