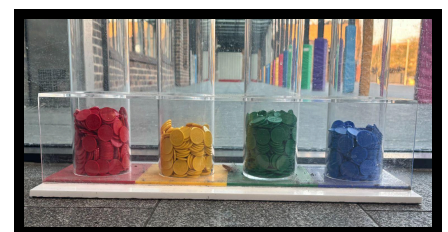
Attendance Ted

Birthday Books 🎂

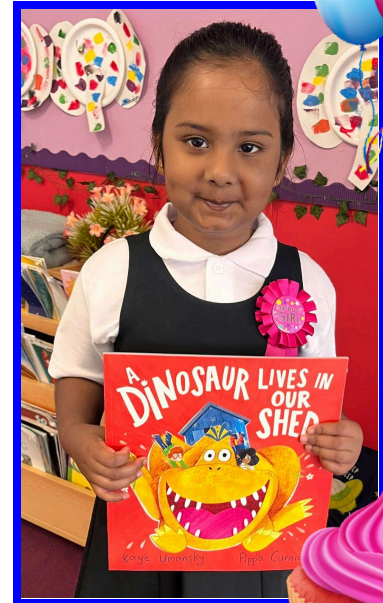
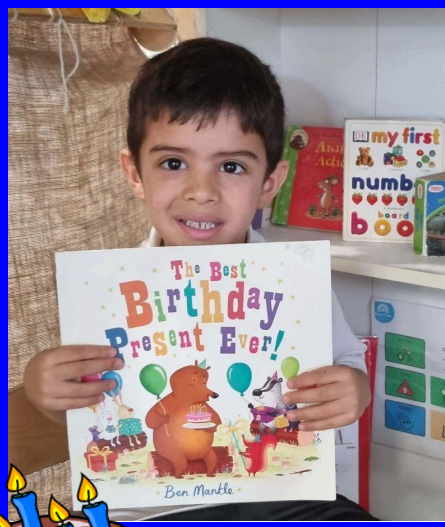

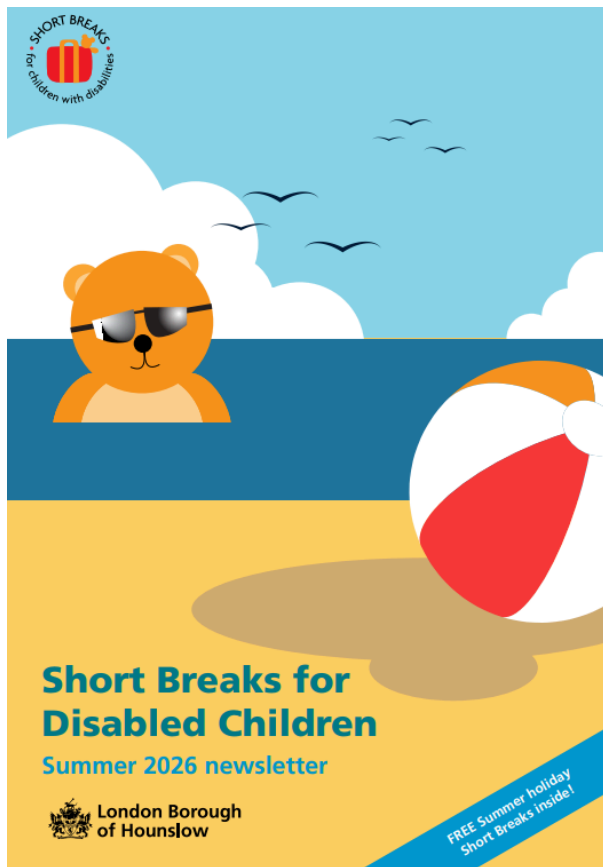

Meningococcal B vaccination programme



We have been asked to share information about the new Meningococcal B (Men B) vaccination programme. Although this does not impact pupils at primary level, lots of families have older children that could benefit from this programme especially if they are about to go to university.

The programme is open to young people born between **1 Sept 2007 and 31 August 2008**.

From **20th July 2026**, the MenB vaccine will be available through participating community pharmacies across England. **The aim is to offer protection to as many eligible young people as possible before the start of the 2026/27 academic year.**
